DIRECTOR'S NOTE:

The Spitfire Grill is a story about what happens to a small community when they lose hope. The community members are isolated, secretive, and suspicious. They're just getting by or are looking for a way to leave. It takes an outsider with a fresh perspective to make them see the value in what they already possess and restore their hope.

Isn't it so with life? Humans have overcome a lot over the course of history if they've had hope. When hope goes, it's difficult to keep moving forward.

Originally a 1996 film with a more tragic ending, The Spitfire Grill premiered as a musical off-Broadway at Playwrights Horizons in New York City on September 7, 2001, just a few days before the attacks on the Twin Towers. Reviewers noted how poignant this show felt to a city and a nation in mourning, thanks to the soulful music and a more triumphant and hopeful ending.

It feels poignant to be directing this musical when we've all just lived through a time of isolation and suspicion. In many ways, we are still living in it. My hope is stories like The Spitfire Grill will compel us to examine how we all might be more compassionate, forgiving, and hopeful.

As we've worked hard to craft this production about community, hope, and healing it has been a privilege to watch the cast come together as a community of artists to support each other, take care of each other, and lift each other up. They give me hope.

Room (TMR) in Orange where she has been dancing for many years.




Barry Ko (Joe Sutter) is so thankful for the opportunity to be a part of this production and the chance to continue growing and pushing outside of his comfort zone!
